
## Are Remote Sites Generators if They Transfer Hazwaste?

Question: Are remote sites that comply with applicable rules required to answer 'yes' to the Business Activities Question: Does your facility generate hazardous waste?

Answer: No. A remote site should respond 'No' to this question. Pursuant to the provisions of HSC 25110.10, hazardous waste initially collected at a remote site and subsequently transported to a consolidation site, shall be deemed to be generated at the consolidation site for purposes of this chapter if the generator complies with the notification requirements..." (emphasis added). Since the waste at the remote site is not deemed to have been generated until it gets to the consolidation site the remote site is not technically a generator. Additionally, a remote site is not required to have an EPA ID number.
